Prior to Your Visit

Once Your Appointment is Made

You'll be asked to fill out or update documentation both prior to your visit as well as the day of your exam. Some of this can be attained through pre-registration over the phone or acquiring forms to fill out before you arrive to make the visit go more smoothly. Current healthcare requirements make it a necessity, while completing this in advance makes it more convenient for you. Confirm necessary referrals and records are received. Plan to arrive early. Once a patient, visit our patient portal for convenient access.

What to Bring to Your Visit

You'll need to provide and bring the following:

- insurance card(s)
- photo ID
- x-rays, MRI scan, CT scan – any tests received elsewhere pertinent to your appointment
- current medication list
- co-pays are due at time of visit

For Your Convenience Regarding Your Rx

- 24-48 hour notice is required for prescription refill requests
- NO prescription refills or narcotics are prescribed after office hours
- leave physician's name, patient's name, date of birth, medication name, dosage, pharmacy name & pharmacy phone number in your phone message
- Call your pharmacy prior to getting your prescription to ensure it is ready for pick up
